Power Wheels Derby Rules and Registration

Event Rules, Requirements, and Registration Information

Monday, Aug. 31, 2026

Eligibility and Safety Requirements

- Participants will compete in two age groups: ages 3–5 and ages 6–8.
- A helmet and closed-toe shoes are required. Bicycle helmets are permitted.
- Each child must be accompanied by one legal parent or guardian. No exceptions. All other family members and friends must remain in the grandstand area.
- If a child exits the Power Wheels vehicle during the event, the child and vehicle will be removed from the competition.

Check-In and Inspection

- Please enter through Gate 4 to the Horse Ring (Derby Track) at least 60 minutes before the contest for Power Wheels inspection.

Vehicle Requirements

- Secure the doors and hood so they cannot open during the event. Bungee cords or zip ties are recommended.
- Seat belts are not required, but they are recommended.
- No special reinforcements are allowed. Vehicles must remain as originally sold in stores.
- Only standard Power Wheels vehicles are allowed. Four-wheelers (ATVs) and motorcycles are not permitted.
- Vehicles must remain at their original height. Raising or lowering either end of the Power Wheels is not allowed.
- Factory batteries may be replaced only with a 6-, 12-, or 24-volt battery. The battery may be placed anywhere inside the vehicle except the passenger seat, and it must be secured and covered.
- Tires must remain stock. Screws, Velcro, or any other materials may not be attached to the tires.
- Nothing may be added to strengthen or reinforce the vehicle. Painting, numbering, and decorating are strongly encouraged.

Competition Format

- The event will use derby-style driving. Each participant will receive two balloons to attach to the front and rear of the vehicle.
- Once the derby begins, children will try to pop or dislodge other competitors' balloons.
- When both balloons are popped or dislodged, the Power Wheels vehicle and driver will be removed from the track.

Fees, Awards, and Notices

- The \$12 entry fee, submitted with this form, includes admission to the fair for that day only.
- All children will receive a participation ribbon. Winners will receive a trophy.
- Rules, dates, and times are subject to change without notice.
- The entry deadline is Friday, Aug. 21, 2026.
